Powering Nevada's Immunization Registry

WHAT IS NEVADA WEBIZ?

Nevada WebIZ is an online computer immunization registry. Nevada WebIZ stores immunization records in one place. Doctors, nurses, schools, and other medical professionals who use Nevada WebIZ can access a person's record, enter the vaccines they gave a person, and see other vaccines that a person has received. Nevada WebIZ stores records for both children and adults.



WHY SHOULD I OR MY CHILD BE IN NEVADA WEBIZ?

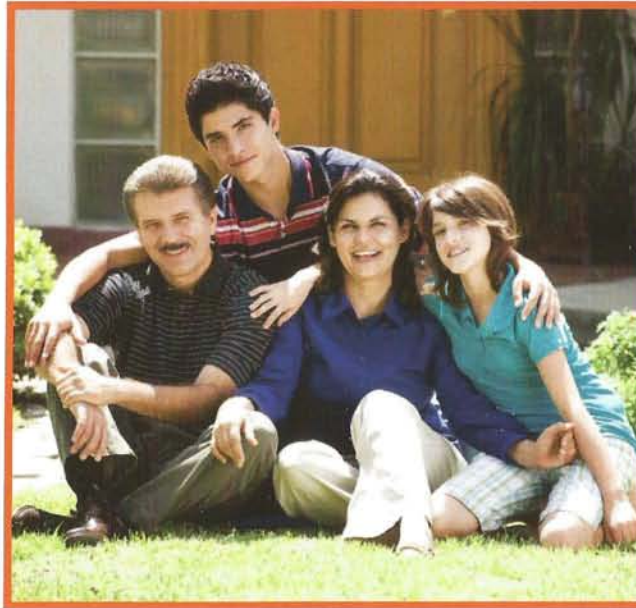
Imagine losing your child's record. How would you prove that your child has received all their vaccines for school, daycare, or summer camp? **What if you lost your record?** How would you prove that you have received your vaccines for work, college, or travel purposes?

Nevada WebIZ can keep track of all vaccines. If you do lose your record, a new one can be printed!

Nevada WebIZ prints an Official Immunization Record.

IS NEVADA WEBIZ CONFIDENTIAL?

Yes! State law requires that information in Nevada WebIZ be kept confidential. Only doctors, nurses, schools, and other medical professionals have access to your information. The information will not be shared with other people or any other agency.



HOW CAN I GET MY OR MY CHILD'S IMMUNIZATION RECORD?

You can now securely print an official record from your home computer by visiting the Nevada WebIZ Public Access Portal at:

izrecord.nv.gov

You can also ask your doctor for a copy or request one by calling our Help Desk at 775-684-5954 or toll free at 1-877-NV-WebIZ.

Official copies obtained from the Nevada State Immunization Program or through the Public Access Portal are **FREE!!!**



OPTING OUT

According to state law, all immunizations given to children and adults must be recorded in Nevada WebIZ, but you can always decline to participate by signing a form at the doctor's office.

Remember, if you lose your immunization record, you may never be able to prove that you or your child have received vaccines.

Tracking down a medical record can cost time and money. Your medical record may be in storage or have been destroyed, depending on how long ago you saw a doctor. You may have no choice but to receive all your vaccines again. This is time consuming and costly.

Nevada WebIZ stores all immunizations in one secure location.

NEW! Public Access Portal

Nevada WebIZ is pleased to announce the creation of the Public Access Portal!

Nevada WebIZ is a confidential online computer system used statewide by doctors and nurses to keep track of their patients' immunizations. Through the new Public Access Portal website:

- Parents and legal guardians can print official immunization records for their child(ren) (ages 0 through 17 years) and
- Adult individuals (ages 18 years and over) can print official immunizations records for themselves.

This is an official record and can be used as proof of immunization for school entry, summer camp, employment, etc.

6 Easy Steps to Finding a Record Through the Public Access Portal

1. Ask your doctor to add Social Security Number (SSN) to your and/or your child(ren)'s Nevada WebIZ record.

SSN's are protected in Nevada WebIZ and cannot be learned by people accessing the system.

2. Visit the Public Access Portal at:

izrecord.nv.gov

3. Enter the Last Name, First Name, Date of Birth, Gender and SSN of the person whose record you are searching for and click "Search."
4. Once a record is found, click "Print Official Immunization Record."
5. When prompted, enter your First Name, Last Name, Phone Number and your relationship to the person named on the record in the pop-up window.
This lets us keep track of who is using the Portal and which records they are requesting. This also allows us to restrict access to records per Nevada law.
6. Print and/or save the Official Immunization Record (Adobe .pdf format).
